

### **PUBLIC HEALTH CHALLENGE**

The outdated practice of referrals to a specialist in primary care medical offices is a detriment to patients, especially low-wealth patients. Traditional specialist referrals often lead to long wait times, missed data and results along with inconsistent care for patients. A report from the Institute for Healthcare Improvement and the National Patient Safety Foundation notes that of the more than 100 million subspecialist referrals requested each year in the United States, only half are completed.





In March 2020, site visits to the HERO Database increased by X percent as the COVID-19 pandemic affected our community.
