2004, January 1 - Memorial University Medical Center goes smoke-free!

2005, July 1 - The "Georgia Smokefree Air Act of 2005" goes into effect



2011, January 1, 12:00pm - The City of Savannah enacts the Savannah Smoke-Free Air Ordinance!!

2011 - Savannah-Chatham County Public School System adopts a Smoke-Free policy.



2011, August 1 - Armstrong State University becomes a Smoke-Free campus.

2012, February 24 - Chatham County commissioners vote to approve the Smoke-Free ordinance for county-wide implementation.



2012, March 25 - Chatham County goes Smoke-Free!!

2014, March - The Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia votes to approve a Tobacco and Smoke-Free Campus Policy.

2014, October 1 - All Georgia Universities are now Tobacco and Smoke-Free!!

2014, December 1 - City of Pooler votes to approve the Clean Air Bill

2015, January 1 - City of Pooler is Smoke-Free!!











Georgia Smoke Free Air Cont'd.

January 1, 2016 - All Federal Housing developments in Savannah Ga are smoke free.

February 3, 2017- The US Department of Housing and Urban Development bans smoking in all public housing, after almost two years of attempts.



April 14, 2017- The new Atlanta Braves stadium, SunTrust Park, opens tobacco free!
